<sup>\*</sup> The U.S. Department of Homeland Security requires international students (F-1 visa holders) to enroll in at least 12 credit units each semester to maintain their legal status in the U.S. The tuition of \$5,900 covers 12 credit units (with usually four 3-unit courses).

Students will also pay: 1) Application fee of \$175; 2) International student health insurance (approximately \$600/semester); 3) Housing and food; and 4) Books, course materials, supplies, and equipment.
